## Clark Construction Achieves Historic Safety Milestone <u>15 Years With No Lost Time Due to Injury</u>

Clark Construction Company has achieved yet another safety milestone as the company has now surpassed <u>15 years with no lost time due to injury</u>. The landmark accomplishment is another in a series of safety achievements that has led Clark Construction to be widely recognized as national leader in safety among construction industry peers.

"It has been extremely gratifying to see our entire team embrace the importance of safety in the workplace, which is really the reason we have achieved this remarkable milestone," said Clark Construction CEO Charles Clark. In addition to reaching the 15-year mark without lost time due to injury, Clark expects to surpass four million job hours without lost time during calendar year 2016, which is an unprecedented accomplishment in the commercial construction industry,

Clark management and staff have consciously refused to accept accidents as an unavoidable aspect of construction and set a safety goal for the company of zero hours of lost time due to injuries. The resulting program has earned Clark Construction widespread government and industry recognition for its safety accomplishments, receiving several major awards in recent years, including:

- **CET Platinum Award** from MIOSHA for outstanding accomplishments in safety;

- **Outstanding Safety Performance Award** from the Accident Fund Insurance Company of America;
